SCHEDULE of FEES

(in Philippine Pesos)

Income for IBCAP's operating expenses comes from two sources: the College Builders Program and student fees. The College Builders Program (gifts from sponsoring churches and individuals) supports the operating costs of the central office and administration of the college. Student fees are used to support the expenses of each teaching center. Every effort is made to keep student costs to a minimum, and this fee schedule is reviewed annually.

Fees for the current academic year are listed as follows:

Application Fee:	1,000
This is a one time fee for processing the student's application for enrollment.	
Matriculation Fee:	1,000/semester
Payable at the beginning of each semester for administrative and operating expenses.	
Tuition Fee (full-time students):	600/course
Payment may be made upon matriculation or prorated monthly. Fees for part time students may be obtained at the IBCAP office.	
Special Fees and Book charges:	Various
Some courses may require additional fees if the student is required to purchase a reference book or if travel or special service activities are required. See the specific course curriculum for details of those requirements and costs.	

FINANCIAL AID

IBCAP has three scholarship programs. These scholarships will vary in size from year-to-year depending on gifts from donors and friends of the IBCAP ministry. Students may be eligible for multiple scholarships depending on their personal situation. It is anticipated that scholarships for the first academic year will be negligible.

General Student Scholarship:

General scholarship monies received from donors and friends of IBCAP will be re-distributed on a pro-rata basis to all students in good standing in the form of a tuition discount.

Full Time Christian Worker's Scholarship:

This scholarship assists full time students in good academic standing whose parent is in full time Christian ministry (as pastor, evangelist, or missionary).

Missionary-Church Planter Scholarship:

For students called by God to minister to un-reached people groups within and beyond the Philippine islands as missionaries, church planters, or itinerate evangelists. Eligibility for this scholarship begins after a student completes the first year of study, and continues as long he remains a student in good standing.
